## Blenheim Palace Gardens Flower Show



Created over the centuries by esteemed garden designers such as Henry Wise and Achille Duchene, the Formal Gardens reflect a journey through the styles of the ages. The Formal Gardens surround the Palace, and they include the majestic Water Terraces, the Duke's Private Italian Garden, the tranquil Secret Garden with all of its hidden treasures, the new Churchill Memorial Garden and the beautifully delicate Rose Garden.

The visitor can look out for statues and art as well as explore the Gardens. In addition to temporary visiting pieces, you can discover permanent fixtures including 'Untitled' by German artist Georg Baselitz and admire one of Capability Browns most famous landscape creations.

There is a Lakeside walk to the beautiful Rose garden and you can stroll through the water terraces to see the ornate fountains or visit the New Winston Churchill Memorial Garden.
