Great Comp Garden and Lullingstone Castle, Kent



Great Comp Garden is a Georgian farmhouse and garden, near the hamlet of Comp in Kent. The garden has built up an enviable reputation over the years as being one of Kent's finest gardens to visit. It showcases 7 acres of beautiful and rare plants surrounding a 17th century manor house and is home to an Italian garden. Summer brings warmth and extravagance from collections of Salvias. Ornamental grasses punctuate the colourful borders.

Lullingstone Castle is one of England's oldest family estates, dating back to the time of Domesday. The World Garden combines plant heritage with cutting-edge horticulture. It contains rare and important botanical plants from around the globe planted in their respective continents of origin. The price includes a conducted tour by the Curator, Tom Hart Dyke.
