

Discounts available to Members in 2013

Discounts on purchases of gardening items **may** be obtained from the following firms on presentation of your current membership card. In the past, the amount of discount has varied from firm to firm and ranging from 5% to 20%, with a minimum purchase value in some cases.

Please note the following points:

1. Membership cards are for the sole use of the named member and are not transferable.
2. Membership cards must be shown **before** any items are rung up on the till.
3. Only garden items are eligible for discounts and some of these are sometimes excluded, for example goods already discounted or on special offer, furniture, fencing, buildings, paving and gas bottles.
4. If the level of discount is a deciding factor on purchase it is advisable to check the terms before commitment. In any event, members are asked to accept the decision of the firm without demur to avoid the possibility of the discount being withdrawn.

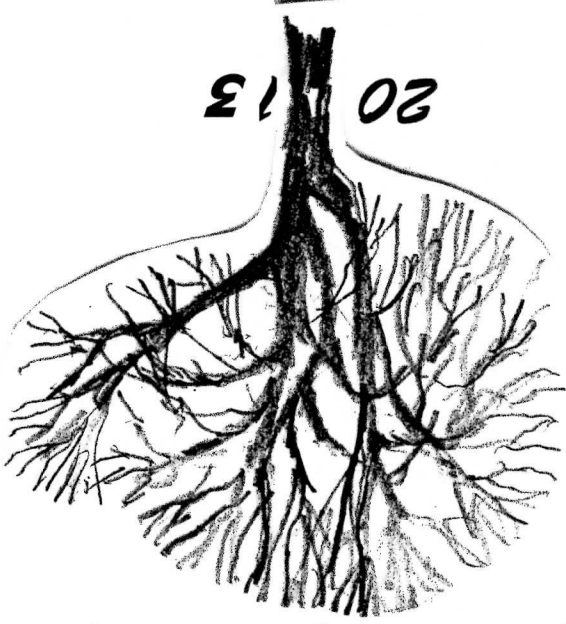
